



Volunteer Crop Tester - Role Description

Role	Crop Tester
Description	We are looking for an individual who would like to volunteer their time to help with collecting data on crop nutrient uptake. This will involve visiting field sites with a chlorophyll meter and using the instrument to take readings of crop 'greenness'. This data is related to nitrogen uptake and will feed into a project with a local farmer collaboration group on fertiliser use efficiency and impacts on water quality.
Time Commitments needed	One day per week from mid-March for 10 weeks (or with a larger team of volunteers, commitments could be shared on a fortnightly basis).
Location	Multiple locations in the Waveney catchment, near to Harleston and Bungay. Driving license essential.
Training	The Trust's Catchment Project Officer would provide all necessary training. Use of a smartphone is essential.
Expenses	Mileage expenses will be reimbursed at £0.45 per mile.
